Provisional timeline:

- Article submission deadline: 27 February 2024
- First round of review: 30 July 2024
- First papers published: 30 November 2024

Scope: A topical issue titled "Vibroacoustics" will be published in Acta Acustica, the Journal of the European Acoustics Association, in 2024. The sub-topics of the special issue include:

- Modeling and numerical methods in vibroacoustics
- Acoustics of porous and structured materials
- Inverse methods in vibroacoustics

A limited number of presenters at Forum Acusticum 2023, the 10th Convention of the European Acoustics Association will be invited by the Editors of the topical issue to submit a paper, on the basis of the impact and novelty of their presentation and conference papers. Authors will be invited to submit a full-length Scientific Article or a Review Article, and will be particularly encouraged to make the data or code that support the findings of this study publicly available. For the submission visit the Acta Acustica website <https://acta-acustica.edpsciences.org/>, and choose the category "Special Issue: Vibroacoustics".

The article processing charge for Acta Acustica is 1000 € in 2024, but as a corresponding author you may be eligible for financial support. Details can be found at <https://acta-acustica.edpsciences.org/author-information/are-youentitled-to-a-special-rate>. In particular, the European Acoustical Association can support you with 500 € and you will be charged 500 €. You can ask your national acoustical association for the payment of the other half of the amount.

Guidelines for submitting an extended conference paper to Acta Acustica:

- The submission needs to be **significantly extended from the original conference paper, with additional material included and an extended literature review**, in order to reach typically 8-12 pages long (final typeset length);

- The extended conference paper needs to be a **strong research article with a broader scope and interest than the conference presentation**;
- The authors should **indicate that their contribution is an improvement, or extension to their previously published conference paper. The conference paper should be cited in the reference list** and throughout the research article;
- **The normal peer review process of the journal will apply.**
